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Terra West Management is horrible and their phone system is outdated. There are so many prompts they ask you to dial and then once you connect to an actual phone, you have to leave a voicemail. Any questions or concerns have to be addressed via email (which may take awhile to receive a response).

I recently moved into the neighborhood in April of this year and the realtor gave me the keys to the pool area. However, the keys are no longer valid due to the transition of using cards to obtain access into the pool area. I was told to drive to the Terra West location on S. Cimmaron Road to obtain a key card. Upon arrival the young girl at the front desk told me that each home is assigned to 2 pool key cards and anything after that is \$5 per card. She mentioned the previous home owner may have the key card still. Isn't it Terra West's obligation and duty to obtain all key(s) once a home owner moves out? Including gate remotes and pool keys?

Anyways, I paid the \$5 with a check because she stated that they no longer accept cash or card as a form of payment. With technology advancing, you'd think this piece of shit HOA management would allow these forms of payment but apparently they're stuck in the 80/90's because they only want you to pay w/ a personal check or money order.

I came back to the office the next day with a personal check and the front desk girl processed my transaction and gave me my pool keys.

HERE'S THE SPOILER: I came to the pool hoping to gain access to the pool BUT guess what? The pool card doesn't work!!!! What a waste of time, energy, and effort! I went back and forth to that damn office just to pay for a malfunctioning key card!

If you like your time wasted by a shitty ass HOA management this for sure is the place to be! There are other nice neighborhoods throughout the Las Vegas Valley that have respectable and outstanding HOA management however Terra West is not one of them. Its a shame that Terra West's customer service isn't up to par, considering the various fees they ask you to pay for in order to live in their neighborhood.



They even have towed truck companies outside waiting to tow people's cars all day long. (Many of my friends cars have Been towed) each people probably paid around \$300 to get their car back! I bet the Hoa have a deal with the towing company. So just think how much people they Fck over everyday! Just anyway to get any money out of the people living here. They charged me for any little fines and fees they can get. Didn't bother to call me or email me. I was never told about these fines. Instead the hoa sent \$3750 of fines to collections. They even put a lien on my house for \$4370. I couldn't sell my house unless I pay the collection agency. Most of the fines are for(no prove of lease) umm Hello?! I own the home! You should know I own the house if you guys did your home work! Okay my mistake is I didn't really check my mail properly but still \$4300 FINE for a prove of a piece of paper is just out rages. Anyhow I didn't want to deal with them any longer so I paid for their Hoa demands and closing fees and fines. Then they still charged me for monthly HOA dues after my house was sold and closed. How can you say it's my job to let you know my house is sold? What are the HOA closing fees and demands for? Makes no sense! Long story short! These HOAs really don't help residence when it comes to anything that needs to be fixed in the neighborhood but they charge you for any little thing that's not "their standards") when the whole neighborhood looks like shit! This is a terrible company to try and work with. Hostile employees, inability to get through phone screening. overbearing attitude and more. Very poor at answering emails or returning phone calls. In my case, when I raised an issue about trimming of trees under their management, instead of a civil answer I received a two page certified/registerd letter from their law firm.

Stay as far away from these people as you can.







We have been waiting 4 months for them to come fix issues around the house. Renters Rights in Nevada is in Our favor not theirs. I will be withholding rent until All Issues are Repaired.







This HOA needs to rename itself Terrible West HOA. The office staff is hostile and authoritarian in attitude. Customer service pathetic.

They hire retirees with low self esteem that are mad at the world, to police the community. These over zealous patrols have nothing better to do than look for frivolous "violations".

We recently sold our home due to constant harassment of letters for such violations:

- 1. Urine spots on the lawn from neighbors' dogs.
- 2. Dandelions on lawn, considered weeds
- 3. Tree suckers in lawn due to shallow root system of two quaking aspens. An issue that has been going on 15 years.
- 4. Garbage can left out overnight, or not put back within an hour of pick up!
- 5. Some homeowners are being forced to redo driveways due to minor cracks, and not one section, the entire 3 car driveway such that the concrete looks the same!
- 6. Tire marks on driveway!
- 7. Other homeowners are being forced to repaint their homes because the NAZI patrol feels the paint has faded.
- 8. One homeowner was fined \$100 for ironing clothes inside her home, her work was visible from the street.
- 9. A friend was fined for washing a rug in her driveway.

Experience after experience dealing with this management company is terrible. I will never live in a property managed by them again. Perhaps



they treat homeowners better but as a renter we were treated very poorly. As mentioned by other reviews, they focus on things like towing a resident's car with expired registration (by 2 weeks) or send you a notice if your trash can is outside your garage one day past trash pick up instead of the actual safety of the neighborhood & customer service to residents.

In addition, they find every possible way they can to get money out of you. Our newest issue is that we paid \$25 for a pool key last summer. Over the winter, they moved the key card reader from inside the pool gate to outside and therefore our key stopped working. After talking to some other residents, it didn't affect everyone- some keys still work but not ours. TWMS told us we have to pay the \$25 for a new pool key as a "reprocessing fee". They did the same thing with gate clickers a few months ago. Ridiculous.
